The mission of Naomi's House is to offer hope and healing to women who have suffered from commercial sexual exploitation by providing resources to begin a new life. Naomi's House is a faith based, non-profit organization and is seeking applicants who have a personal relationship with Christ, seeking to make a difference in the world.

Reset in Elgin provides drop-in services offered by Naomi's House to community members who have been impacted by commercial sexual exploitation or are at risk of becoming exploited. Reset offer intensive case management that includes emotional, education, and employment support to excel in personal goals that have been interrupted due to various life obstacles.

Position Overview: Case Manager Internship

The Case Manager is under the supervision of the site Program Manager. The Case Manager is responsible for providing individual and family case management as assigned at Reset in Elgin.

Internship Job Responsibilities: Case Manager

- Create participant and family individual care plans (ICP)
- Provide weekly individual and family support in case management sessions to assist participants in meeting goals on their ICPs
- Assessing quarterly progress of client's goal and adjusting goals accordingly
- Connect participants to community resources to meet client's needs and goals
- Attend individual and group supervisions
- Track all case management notes online on SharePoint
- Schedule case management appointments in program calendar
- Assisting Program Manager in program development initiatives

Education Requirements:

Intern must be in 3rd or 4th year of Bachelor's degree pursuing social services degree such as Social Work, Human Services, Psychology, etc. Must have reliable transportation and ability to transport clients is a plus.
