Position Overview: Clinical Internship – Residential Case Manager

The Clinical Case Manager seeks to support participants in the program in collaboration with the Program Advocate and under the supervisory license of the Clinical Program Manager of Reside.

Office Location: Wheaton

Job Responsibilities:

- Conducts initial phone screen for NH applicants and reviews with Program Advocate
- Assists with administrative tasks as assigned by the Program Advocate
- Shadows Program Advocate in case management
- Meets with participants weekly to develop individual care plan and equip participants with social service needs and in meeting their stage goals in case management
- Transport participants to individual appointments
- Manages participant medications in accordance with Naomi's House policy and procedure
- Participates on the graduation committee for graduation ceremonies and transition

Experience and Qualifications

- A personal and growing relationship with Jesus Christ and be an active member of a church
- A Master's Degree in Social Work, Psychology or Sociology
- A minimum of two years' experience in behavioral health and residential care
- Training in one or more of the following areas: Human Trafficking, Addictions, and/or Trauma *Certified Alcohol and Other Drugs of Addiction Counselor (CAADC) preferred.*
- Effective skills working in diverse settings with multi-disciplinary teams
- Strong oral, written communication skills and listening
- Well-developed ability to engage others in building relationships and sustaining momentum
- Proven capacity to maintain patience, tolerance and tact with diplomacy in high-pressure situations
- High level of integrity and strong ethical values; must maintain the highest standards of confidentiality with all records, including organizational and individual information
